

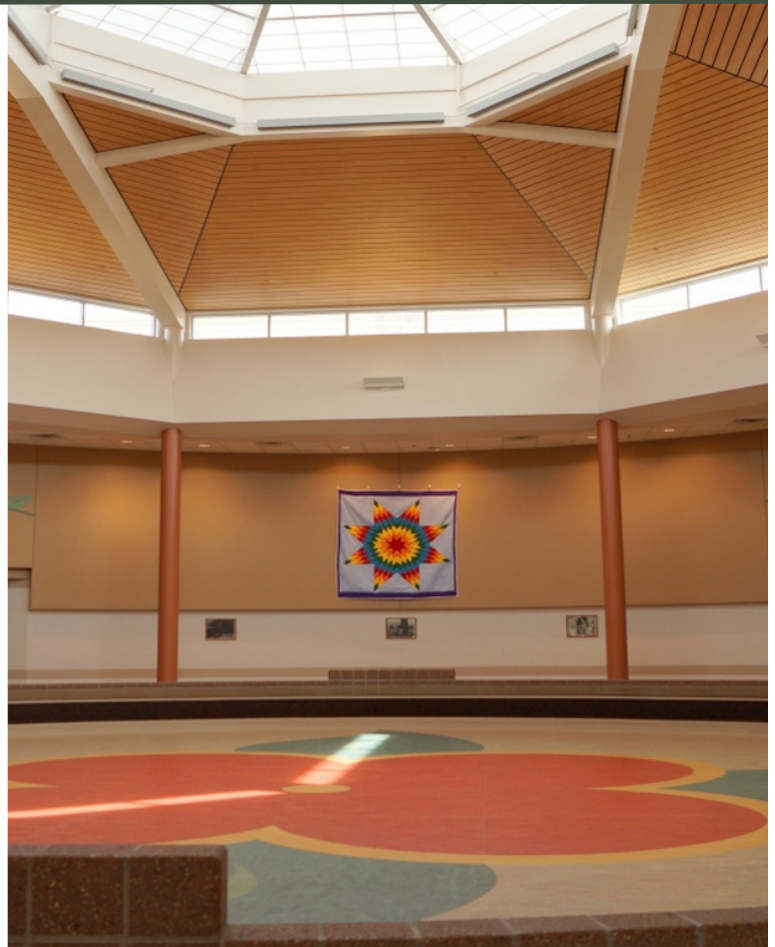
## RELATED EXPERIENCE

*Onamia, Minnesota*

Head Start facility for 200 children ranging from infants to seven year olds. The 48,000 square foot center contains classrooms, an Elder Room for interaction between the MLBO elders and the children, a Gymnasium and a Library. The focus of the building is the Multi-Purpose/ Cultural Center, used for pow-wows, community gatherings and child play.

MLBO's appreciation of the environment is reflected in the sustainable design features which include geothermal heating and cooling, rain gardens, linoleum flooring and the use of daylighting. These features are expected to reduce operating and maintenance costs.
